Interim Pastor:

1. Rev. Graham Ford and the Board of Westminster Fellowship at Duke University effective June 30, 2010. Terms: Salary \$29,300; Housing \$5,714; Social Security \$2,679; Accountable Reimbursement \$3,900; Pension/Medical \$11,029; Moving Expenses \$500. Total \$53,122. Four weeks vacation and four weeks continuing education.
2. Rev. Haywood Holderness and Covenant Presbyterian Church, Wendell effective July 1, 2010 for six months. Terms; Salary and Housing \$2,123.33 (paid twice monthly); Accountable Reimbursement \$650 per month; Social Security offset paid up to 50%. One week paid vacation.

I believe and trust in the one eternally triune God who exists in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The three persons of the God-head, known to us only through God's self revelation, mutually cooperate in all functions of God. Such cooperation reveals the relational nature of the God who desires communion with all of creation.

I believe that God the Father, being Holy and Sovereign, created out of nothing and made all things good. Men and women were created in the image of God and were made for communion with God, for stewardship of the earth and for fellowship with one another. Humanity, through disobedience to God, fell into sin and became subject to death. Though all have sinned, it was through God's grace alone that God chose to make a covenant with Abraham and elect a people, Israel.

I believe that through Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, Word made flesh, fully God and fully human, we are grafted into this covenant. Christ was born for us, and for our salvation. Jesus lived a life free from sin and exhibited God's love through healings, fellowship with sinners, announcing good news to the poor, and embodying God's kingdom. In his life, Jesus demonstrated perfect communion with God, harmony with the earth and how we are to love one another. In his suffering, death and resurrection, Jesus Christ atoned for humanity's sin and conquered death, providing life eternal for all those who trust in him through the power of the Holy Spirit.

I believe that in the Holy Spirit, God's presence and power remain in the world. The Holy Spirit enables a positive response to the Gospel, justifies us by grace through faith, sanctifies and transforms us in God's image, and leads us into prayer and worship.

I believe that the Church is the body of Christ with Jesus Christ as its head. The Church is the visible sign in the world of God's Kingdom as it worships together, preaching the Word of God, administering the sacraments and proclaiming God's reconciling love through the power of the Holy Spirit. The Church embodies the servanthood of Christ by ministering to the poor, and by joining in the struggle to free people from systems of sin, oppression, hunger and injustice. The Church is a foretaste of the kingdom of heaven as it invites people of all nations to live, work and worship together in the peace made available through Jesus Christ.

I believe that Holy Scripture, which is inspired by God and consists of the Old and New Testaments, is the unique and authoritative witness of God's saving work in Jesus Christ. The Church receives guidance and illumination through the reading and hearing of the Word of God, empowered by the Holy Spirit. Scripture, centered in the person and work of Jesus Christ, is the story that guides the Church.

I believe that the Sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper are signs and seals of God's covenantal grace, the Word of God in visible form. In the Sacrament of Baptism, the Holy Spirit cleanses us from sin in the baptismal waters as we die to ourselves and are raised and united with Jesus Christ. It is in Baptism that we are publicly received into Christ's Church. In the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper, we are spiritually fed as the power of the Holy Spirit makes the bread and the cup become for us Christ's body and blood. In the Lord's Supper we are renewed by the memory of Christ's life, death and resurrection, bound with Christ and one another and given a foretaste of the heavenly banquet where all will be fed.

I believe that Christ died, Christ rose, and that Christ will come again. The lamb who was slaughtered will reign, ushering in the fulfillment of God's Kingdom. Every tear will be wiped away and humanity will glorify God and enjoy God forever. I believe that we as the Church, in the already and not yet, trusting that nothing can separate us from the love of God, are called to patiently bear witness to the salvific work of Jesus Christ.
