

First Presbyterian Church of Garner Youth Director - Job Description

Job Title: Youth Director

Role: Youth Director of First Presbyterian Church of Garner shall be a trained professional or student training in Christian Education or related field who is committed to a Christ-centered life. The Youth Director shall possess the administrative skills, and the interpersonal and relational skills needed to work with youth and their families.

Terms: An average of 15-18 hours per week (72 hours per month).
A salary range of \$600-\$800 per month.

Responsibilities:

- Devote an average of 15 hours per week (60 per month) in preparing and carrying out youth group meetings, visits, and special events. Specifics include:
 - Lead the weekly 6th - 12th grade youth group programs and Sunday school.
 - Plan/organize/supervise retreats and special events (beach trip, Montreat, Massanetta).
- Devote up to 12 hours per month in preparing and carrying out an Elementary Children activity program and participating in Vacation Bible School.
- Work with Christian Education Committee to coordinate youth Sunday school program with Sunday night youth group.
- Contribute content for the Church newsletter and website.
- Work with Youth Committee to recruit and train adult volunteers.
- Support youth and families by being involved in their lives (attend special sports events, choral and band concerts).
- Help youth realize they are a vital part of the church.
- Help congregation to realize youth are a vital part of the church.
- Be accessible, flexible, and adaptable to the needs of the youth and FPCOG.
- Be active in worship at FPCOG.
- Work towards long term vision for youth program at FGCOG.

Accountability:

- Report to Senior Pastor.
- Report to Youth Committee at scheduled meetings.
- Provide written reports to Session as requested.
